

**POLICY LIT.9.05
ADVISORY COMMITTEES**

SCOPE: Faculty and Staff

Lamar Institute of Technology (LIT) is committed to advancing technical programs and industry partnerships that drive workforce excellence and economic growth. Each career and technical education program will maintain an industry-based advisory committee. The role of the advisory committee is to ensure the program has adequate resources and a well-designed curriculum to provide students with the knowledge, skills, and abilities essential for employment.

Advisory Committee functions include:

1. Evaluate the goals and objectives of the program curriculum
2. Establish workplace competencies for the program occupation(s)
3. Suggest program revisions as needed
4. Evaluate the adequacy of facilities and equipment
5. Advise LIT personnel on the selection and acquisition of new equipment
6. Identify local business and industry leaders who will provide students with work-based learning experiences, employment, and placement opportunities.
7. Assist in professional development of the faculty
8. Assist in promoting and publicizing the program to the community and to business and industry
9. Represent the needs of students from special populations
10. Identify potential industry-based certifications that could complement student success in the program

Advisory committees serve in a non-binding advisory capacity to support institutional improvement.
