

**POLICY LIT.9.04  
TUTORING**

**SCOPE:** Faculty and Students

Lamar Institute of Technology (LIT) supports tutoring as an important academic support service that contributes to student success. Tutoring must be conducted in a manner that upholds academic integrity, avoids conflicts of interest, and ensures equitable access to academic support

Tutoring services are available online, in-person through Student Services, or in-person from faculty.

1. Faculty, both full and part-time, shall not receive additional compensation for tutoring students enrolled in their own classes and shall not charge students for tutoring services.
2. Faculty providing tutoring should limit assistance to clarification of course concepts, guidance in problem-solving, and structured support that promotes independent learning.
