POLICY LIT.8.09 COLLEGE SUCCESS SKILLS COURSE (DORI)

SCOPE: Faculty, Staff, and Students

Lamar Institute of Technology (LIT) is committed to the success of our students. The College Success Skills Course (DORI) course is designed to provide incoming students with knowledge and skills for effective learning and development, preparing them for higher education and their future careers.

- 1. Students registering at LIT for the first time are required to successfully complete the College Success Skills Course.
 - 1.1. This requirement may be waived if the student:
 - 1.1.1. Has completed a minimum of fifteen (15) semester credit hours of coursework with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0;
 - 1.1.1.1. Only non-developmental coursework is used in the calculation of the GPA.
 - 1.1.2. Is enrolled in the Police Academy, Fire Academy, or EMT Basic courses;
 - 1.1.3. Is enrolled in dual credit courses;
 - 1.1.4. Is a Lamar Institute of Technology faculty or staff member; or
 - 1.1.5. Is a Veteran
- 2. The College Success Skills Course is an institutional requirement for graduation.
