

POLICY LIT.8.01 ELIGIBILITY FOR EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

SCOPE: Students

Lamar Institute of Technology (LIT) recognizes that participation in extracurricular activities contributes significantly to student engagement, leadership development, academic success, and the overall student experience. The College supports student involvement in organizations, activities, competitions, governance, and other approved extracurricular programs while maintaining expectations for academic achievement, responsible conduct, and institutional representation.

1. An extracurricular activity is an activity representing the student body, any student organization, any department or division organization or any general activity representing LIT.
2. Any officially registered, full-time student not on disciplinary or academic probation is eligible to become a candidate for student office, hold student office, or represent LIT in an extracurricular activity
3. Students must have a grade point average of at least 2.0 for both total college work completed at LIT and from the preceding semester.
 - 3.1. For the purpose of establishing eligibility, two six-week summer terms may count as one semester.
 - 3.2. First-semester students (Freshman or Transfer students) are exempt from GPA requirements until completion of one semester.
4. Additional eligibility requirements may apply to specific activities, organizations, competitions, or leadership positions.
