

PROCEDURE LIT.2.01.01
OFFICE OF CAMPUS SAFETY

SCOPE: Faculty and Staff

1. The responsibility for the administration of the LIT Safety Program is assigned to the Director of Safety.
 - 1.1. The Office of Campus Safety is responsible for detecting unsafe conditions and unsafe acts.
2. The Office of Campus Safety performs inspections and reviews inspection reports from all areas periodically to ensure the safety of the LIT work environment.
 - 2.1. The Director of Safety or Environmental Health and Safety Specialist is empowered to stop work functions whenever imminent danger, which can result in serious injury, is noted.
 - 2.2. All discrepancies noted or detected will be remedied either by work order or by the responsible supervisor.
3. Campus Safety Officers patrol the campus to keep employees, students, campus visitors, and facilities safe.
 - 3.1. Services provided by Campus Safety Officers include, but are not limited to:
 - 3.1.1. Safety escorts
 - 3.1.2. Assistance changing a tire
 - 3.1.3. Providing a battery jump
 - 3.1.4. Event security
